Title: Write a descriptive title indicating exactly what you're testing.
Introduction: Describe the problem in 1-3 paragraphs and explain why you are doing the lab, along with background information about what is already known about this problem.
Hypothesis: Before beginning your laboratory assignment, write a statement indicating what you expect to happen and why in 1-2 sentences.
Materials: List the materials necessary to complete this lab.
Procedure: Using a numbering system, write the steps taken to complete the lab. Be sure to include any ways in which your procedure deviated from those listed in the instructions.
Results: Compile all your collected results, including all tables, charts, or numerical data.
Conclusion & Discussion: Interpret the data you collected, indicating whether your hypothesis was supported or not, and include answers to any discussion questions in this section.
